The world map showing where visitors to the CoCoA website come from causes trouble in "private mode" in Firefox:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• the map does not appear (just some placeholder text)• the page tries to load forever• the attempt to load the page BURNS CPU (2 cores max-ed out!)			
The last point is totally unacceptable.
