On my computer: if I CTRL-click on CoCoAInterpreter, a window appears asking if I really want to "open" the file; I say yes; then another window appears saying "Verifying...".

After some time the verification fails, and I have the option to "cancel" or "move to trash". **HOWEVER**, if I start ./CoCoAInterpreter in a shell then it seems to run (and complain that it cannot find the packages...).

What happens if you just do CTRL-click on ConfigEmacs, but do not do it with CoCoAInterpreter? Can you then start CoCoA-5 from inside emacs?

I also had to type in an administrator's username and password (when running as "guest" user).

NOTE even though verification failed (with a worrying message about CoCoAInterpreter being corrupted), I was then able to start it from inside Emacs.
