Now that I started this work I see that it has to be finished urgently.

As it was, the documentation wasn't just obsolete/incomplete, but **inconsistent** and not working (for its inconsistency the "all commands and functions.." sections in the html and TeX versions were built wrongly)

Tagging the types in the syntax actually helps being consistent and automatically produces the complete tables. Moreover avoids duplication of information (the types in **syntax** were repeated in **types**) and make the huge xml easier to read and maintain.
