<b>Description</b> <p>There is an emacs UI function called cocoa5-send-buffer. Its effect is practically identical to that of cocoa5-source-file, the only "advantage" being that cocoa5-send-buffer does not save the buffer (as cocoa5-source-file does). However, if the buffer contains long lines then the *cocoa5* buffer in my emacs 24.1 goes catatonic.</p> <p>I propose removing cocoa5-send-buffer (or commenting it out, or at least removing the key sequence C-c C-b for calling it).</p> <p>Opinions?</p>
