I wanted to show an example to Gereon, but could not find it because I looked for files whose names contained "SparsePoly".

The example in ex-Polylterator2.C contains too much "clutter": the actual code is about 125 lines, but only about 10 of these actually use SparsePolylter. The whole file is about 260 lines.
